

HOW TO GET TO



BY BUS

Door-to-Dorset bus service 103/103A operates between Wool Station and the Tank Museum, Bovington. Some journeys need to be pre-booked (see timetable below).

How to use Door-to-Dorset services:

- 1) Look at the timetable below and decide which times are convenient for your trip to and from the Tank Museum.
- 2) One or both journeys may need to be pre-booked, as indicated by the telephone symbol. If this is the case, ring the booking line on 0845 602 4547. The booking line is open from 0830 to 1700, Mon-Sat. You are advised to book at least 1 hour before departure but bookings may be accepted right up to departure time.

WALK OR TAXI



There is a safe, wheelchair-friendly walking route from Wool Station to the Tank Museum. Allow about 45 minutes.

- 1) Go across the level crossing and follow the footpath past the bus shelter.
- 2) Cross the river using the traffic-free Woolbridge. Keep going until you reach a road junction.
- 3) Take the first turning left signposted "Bovington" and follow this road to the Tank Museum.

If you have a detailed map, you can find your own way to Bovington across the water meadows.



Or take a taxi for one or both journeys! There is a taxi rank at Wool Station. You can call a taxi from the Tank Museum entrance hall (ask at reception desk).
